ONAMI- New External Users Grant Proposals for Shared User Facility Usage

What:

- Matching funds for service charges incurred at ONAMI-supported facilities located within OSUEM, CEMN, CAMCOR³ or MBI³. 50-50 match
- Maximum grant \$2000

Who²:

- Oregon Industry (registered business)
- New users of the shared user facilities

Why:

- ONAMI would like to increase industrial awareness and usage of our characterization and fabrication facilities.
- This program is intended introduce industry to facility capabilities and to provide financial assistance.

ONAMI is accepting applications for matching grants. Hourly rates at the facilities are typically \$200-400/hour depending on the type of equipment. Contact the facility director to get an estimate of project cost.

1 Funds for this matching grant program are allocated to ONAMI by the Oregon State legislature and Business Oregon (<http://www.oregon4bix.com>). Grants will be made based on funds available.

2 Qualification criteria:

- Company must be based in, or have an operating entity in Oregon
- Grants are offered to new and young companies (<10 years) or to existing companies for services related to development of a new product in Oregon
- This grant is applicable to first time clients as defined by the Shared User Facilities.
 - * If a client has not used a facility for >2 years they will be considered new. Each Facility will maintain a current client list.

In addition, a company that has used the MBI fabrication facility may apply for a second grant for use of one of ONAMI's characterization facilities (OSUEM, CAMCOR or CEMN)
